Minutes:

Park:

Streets:

Follow up on Weston Road- Discussed this road being part in the city and part in the county. Council discussed doing nothing with the road. James Winberry asked if there were any updates on the road. Is Blue signed road so City will not maintain. James Winberry wants to maintain.

New Business:

Council was presented with Resolution # 76-State Aid City Street Program Project Resolution. The mayor read the Title. Justin made the motion to adopt Resolution expressing the willingness of the City of Gateway to utilize state aid street monies for the city projects. Sharon 2nd the motion.
