### Financial:

Council reviewed the February Financial Report. Don made the motion to accept the report. Justin 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion.

### Park:

- Cheryl talked to Courtney about leftover grant money for benches. Need to be ADA approved. **\*\*UPDATE\*\***-Will get two (2) wheelchair accessible benches and one (1) regular one with money left over from Grant.

- Will check on pickle ball courts.
- Andrew said before we open them back up need to have steel frames and doors for bathrooms. Getting bids-**\*\*UPDATE\*\***-Bill with Bow Tie Solutions was present and gave info about the steel frames and doors (total cost \$7368.00). Don made the motion to use Bow Tie Solutions to put steel frames and steel doors with closures on the park bathroom. Justin 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All council members were in favor.
- Maybe need to check into different toilets, those clog easily. - Don suggested getting bids from other plumbers for new toilets. -Getting bids-**\*\*UPDATE\*\*** Aut's plumbing looked at toilets. He repressurized tank (was at 65, should be 85) Toilets are flushing good now. Said the drains are fine. Said maybe need to check into sensors and may need to change flush valves. Council agreed that need to check into price of sensors.
- Getting two more cameras for park-**\*\*UPDATE\*\*** Cameras installed
- Andrew cleaned and took out trash. Getting ready to start mowing.

**Streets:**

- Cheryl is going to check with County about mowing right of ways.
- John Wiltgen presented the council quotes to get Clantonville Rd and Cotton Lane Chipped and sealed. Don made the motion to go ahead with it. Steve 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All council members in favor.

**Old Business:**
